ACTIVITY

The programme includes fun-based, thrilling and challenging activities like trekking/hiking, archery, rifle & pistol shooting, horse riding, valley crossing, zip line, parasailing, crossing and encountering obstacles, nature lore and water activities. Participants will be taken for sightseeing in Pachmarhi. A few scouting activities such as morning physical jerks, daily inspection and camp fires at night will also be done.



MEDICAL

- ⊕ Covid PCR test is mandatory for all participants and staff.
- ⊕ Medical fitness certificate from registered medical practitioner is compulsory.
- ⊕ Those with blood pressure, asthma & diabetes should not attend.
- ⊕ First-Aid services will be available at all times.



ACCOMMODATION

Tent or hut accommodation will be provided to all the participants/staff on raised cement platforms.

- ✓ Class VI to XII / Age 13 to 18 yrs - boys & girls.
- ✓ HSB - boys & girls who have passed out between the years 2018 - 2021.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

All centres to reach Pipariyah by evening of 17th May 2021. Departure will be on the night of 22nd May 2021 or the morning of 23rd May 2021.

DUA & IMAMAT NAMAAZ

Daily Dua in the morning and imamat Namaaz (Fajr, Zohar Asar, Maghrib Isha) will be conducted during the camp.
